- Self-trust gradually built
- Active member of society

Perspectives on challenges

- Lack of job stability
- Acculturation stress
- Self-effort against uninviting environment
- Language and social barriers
- Public sector involvement
- Integration?

Observation

- o Same setting as interview facilitated blending
- Flowing number of people of diverse ages and genders
- Groupings depending on type of interactions
 Language clases, meetings, get-togethers and workshops
- Varying use of language in friendly and comfortable environment
- Open area accesible to all, yet orderly, quiet and respectful
 Multicultural engagements held under "house rules"
- Increased awareness of surroundings and face recognition
